

ABSTRAK

HUBUNGAN TINGKAT PENGETAHUAN DENGAN SIKAP PERAWAT DALAM MELAKSANAKAN STANDAR PROSEDUR OPERASIONAL (SPO) *PATIENT SAFETY* DIRUANGAN RAWAT INAP RS. DIRGAHAYU SAMARINDA

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Latar belakang : program pelaksanaan keselamatan pasien sudah dijalankan, namun pelaksanaan di lapangan belum dilaksanakan secara optimal. Masih ada pasien yang belum menggunakan gelang identitas ketika pasien baru masuk, ada pasien yang belum mengerti apa maksud dan tujuan dipasangnya gelang identitas, komunikasi yang dilakukan saat timbang terima belum menggunakan metode SBAR hanya menggunakan komunikasi biasa. yang mengatakan kadang-kadang dilaksanakan double check pada obat high alert. **Tujuan:** penelitian ini menunjukkan untuk mengetahui hubungan sikap perawat dalam melaksanakan standar prosedur operasional (SPO) *patient safety* diruangan rawat inap Rumah Sakit Dirgahayu Samarinda. **Metode penelitian:** jenis penelitian menggunakan *deskriptif analitik* dengan desain *cross sectional*. Sampel pada penelitian ini berjumlah 41 responden dengan teknik *stratified random sampling*. Analisa data menggunakan uji statistik *chi square*, Data dikumpulkan dengan menggunakan kuesioner dimasing-masing variabel. **Hasil:** diperoleh p value 0,09 lebih besar dari 0,05 maka H_a ditolak dan H_0 diterima yaitu tidak ada hubungan antara tingkat pengetahuan dengan sikap perawat dalam melaksanakan Standar Prosedur Operasional (SOP) *Patient Safety* di Rumah Sakit Dirgahayu Samarinda. **Simpulan:** Analisis dalam penelitian ini menggunakan uji statistik *Chi Square* dengan hasil p value 0,09 lebih besar dari 0,05 maka H_a ditolak dan H_0 diterima yaitu tidak ada hubungan antara tingkat pengetahuan dengan sikap perawat dalam melaksanakan Standar Prosedur Operasional (SOP) *Patient Safety* di Rumah Sakit Dirgahayu Samarinda.

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ABSTRACT

RELATIONSHIP OF KNOWLEDGE LEVEL WITH NURSE ATTITUDES IN IMPLEMENTING STANDARD OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES (SPO) PATIENT SAFETY IN INHALMING RS. DIRGAHAYU SAMARINDA

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Background: the patient safety implementation program has been implemented, but the implementation in the field has not been implemented optimally. There are still patients who have not used an identity bracelet when a new patient arrives, there are patients who do not understand what the purpose and purpose of placing an identity bracelet is, the communication that is carried out when weighing in does not use the SBAR method only uses ordinary communication. That said sometimes double checks are carried out on high alert drugs. **Purpose:** This study shows the relationship between nurses' attitudes in implementing standard operating procedures (SPO), patient safety in the inpatient room of Dirgahayu Hospital, Samarinda. **Research method:** this type of research used descriptive analytic with cross sectional design. The sample in this study amounted to 41 respondents with a stratified random sampling technique. Data analysis used chi square statistical test. Data were collected using a questionnaire in each variable. **Results:** obtained p value 0.09 is greater than 0.05, so H_a is rejected and H_0 is accepted, that is, there is no relationship between the level of knowledge and the attitude of nurses in implementing Patient Safety Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) at Dirgahayu Hospital, Samarinda. **Conclusion:** The analysis in this study uses the Chi Square statistical test with a p value of 0.09 which is greater than 0.05, so H_a is rejected and H_0 is accepted, that is, there is no relationship between the level of knowledge and the attitude of nurses in implementing Patient Safety Standard Operating Procedures (SOP). at Dirgahayu Hospital Samarinda.
